For example, Wasilla Bible Church in Alaska has global partners on every inhabitable continent. Pray for more of these fruitful partnerships in Acts 29!	Pray that those in the pews of Acts 29 churches open their hearts to Jesus.
Pray for pastor's wives who are in the thick of ministry alongside their husbands.	Pray for the 40 churches in Acts 29 Latin America, including their pastors. Church planters in this region like Freddy Nava in Venezuela, a lawyer-turned- church planter with a growing church, need our prayers. Pray for their work to expand throughout the region!	Pray for those planting out of Acts 29 churches who often say bittersweet goobyes to see the gospel continue to flourish through church planting. For example, pray for Joey Presutti who is planting a church in St. Johns, FL after being a part of The District Church and Church of Eleven22 in Jacksonville, FL.	Pray for potential planters to be raised up to plant more churches. Pray that they can be identified and trained well to do the work of church planting. Pray for church planters who are hurting personally and professionally. Pray that Acts 29 can support them well when ministry is hard.	Pray for the church planters involved in Project Planta- dor, a Brazilian initiative to provide a two-year program for church planters where relationships are formed, men are trained, communities are built, churches are planted, and God is glorified.	Pray for the 48 churches in Acts 29 Asia-Pacific. Pray for strong church-to-church partnerships. These are a key part of the ministry strategy and ensure resources find the churches that need them the most.
